Ring 1: RIDDEN PONY RING.

Starting at 2.30pm

Class

1. **Lead Rein Pony** – For Novice and Open Lead Rein ponies. To include Show Pony, Show Hunter and M&M Lead Rein ponies.
2. **First Ridden Pony** - For Novice and Open First Ridden ponies. To include Show Pony, Show Hunter and M&M First Ridden ponies.
3. **Family Pony Ridden** – Riders under 12 years.
4. **Family Pony Ridden** – Riders over 12 years.
5. **M&M Ridden, Small Breeds** – For Novice and Open Ridden Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B Ponies. Riders any age.
6. **M&M Ridden, Large Breeds** – For Novice and Open Ridden Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D Ponies. Riders any age.
7. **Show Hunter Pony, up to 133cms** – For Novice and Open Show Hunter Ponies not exceeding 133cms.
8. **Show Hunter Pony, up to 153cms** – For Novice and Open Show Hunter Ponies over 133cms but not exceeding 153cms.
9. **Show Pony, up to 128cms** – For Novice and Open Show Ponies not exceeding 128cms.
10. **Show Pony, up to 148cms** – For Novice and Open Show Hunter Ponies over 128cms but not exceeding 148cms.
11. **Intermediate Show Riding Type** – For Novice and Open Intermediate Ponies over 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
12. **Intermediate Show Hunter Type** – For Novice and Open Intermediate Ponies over 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.

NB. All stallions, in any Class at an I.P.S. Affiliated Show, must be ridden by riders who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January of current year and must have obtained permission from the I.P.S. Council to compete.
